

Do You Need a Spanish Interpreter to Access Court Services?

Do you have a case in the San Juan County Court?

Do you speak Spanish and have trouble speaking or understanding English?

You can request the services of an interpreter for many phases of the court process, including hearings, at no cost to you.

IF YOU NEED AN INTERPRETER, THIS IS WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- **FOR SUPERIOR COURT:** Fill out the form below and take it to the Superior Court Administrator's Office, 2nd Floor, San Juan County Courthouse. **DO THIS 2-5 DAYS BEFORE YOUR HEARING.**
- If you have more than one hearing, use additional forms.
- If your hearing is cancelled or the date changes, you must immediately tell the Superior Court Administrator's Office, by calling (360) 370-7480 or in-person at the Superior Court Administrator's Office (2nd Floor, Courthouse) This will let the Court cancel the interpreter.
