Canvassing Board Review and Certification Meetings August 6, 2019 Primary

August 19, 2019 — Review

Auditor Milene Henley called the Canvassing Board Review Meeting to order at 8:48 a.m. on Monday, August 19, 2019, at the San Juan County Elections office.

Mr. Cain served as the designee for Prosecuting Attorney Randall K. Gaylord.

Ms. Armstrong provided a flowchart explaining how reissued and replacement ballots are processed in light of new legislation around Same Day Registration.

Canvassing Board members reviewed challenged envelopes and ballots as follows:

The Canvassing Board reviewed and accepted three challenged ballots. Two were voter intent issues. One was a King County ballot that was received in a San Juan County ballot envelope. The King County ballot shared no races with the current San Juan County ballot for the voter. It was determined that the voter would get credit for voting and the ballot would be duplicated and processed as a blank ballot. Mr. Stephens

questioned why the ballot was not forwarded to King County. Ms. Armstrong answered that the voter is currently registered in San Juan County.

The Canvassing Board reviewed five other challenges. The first challenge concerned a ballot returned with no ballot envelope and no declaration. The ballot was rejected. The second challenge related to a ballot packet not correctly assembled and with no signed declaration. The ballot was tentatively rejected, and Ms. Armstrong was requested by the Canvassing Board to attempt to contact the voter and request a signature in order to cure the ballot. The next two challenged ballots had envelopes from the 2018 November General Election. Ms. Henley opened the ballot envelopes and the Canvassing Board confirmed that the ballots were from the 2018 November General Election. The last challenge concerned a ballot envelope with a signature that did not match. There was a note on the ballot envelope to please open and read the note inside. Ms. Henley opened the ballot envelope and read a request to remove the voter from registration lists because the voter has dementia. Ms. Armstrong noted that the voter will be sent a cancellation form.

The Canvassing Board reviewed five informational ballots. The first three were first issue ballots for which the voter had also returned their current ballot. Ms. Henley questioned the legality of voters returning two ballots. Ms. Armstrong noted that the rules have changed because of updated legislation around Same Day Registration. The two inserts for replacement and reissued ballots were provided for the Canvassing Board to review.

Ms. Armstrong noted that the fourth informational ballot was from a voter who returned her un-voted ballot in person claiming that she had already voted in the election.

Ms. Armstrong explained that the fifth informational ballot was received from a non-citizen who had been registered through the Department of Licensing. The non-citizen's son-in-law called asking why she had received a voter ID card. Ms. Armstrong sent a cancellation form. The Elections office received the non-citizen's voted ballot with a signed declaration of citizenship and subsequently received the signed cancellation form. The ballot was not counted.

Ms. Armstrong also noted that updated signatures were requested from voters whose signatures were able to be verified but were different enough to warrant consideration.

Ms. Armstrong presented the post-election audit report and explained this new audit procedure. Ms. Henley noted that another type of audit, Risk Limiting Audit, is also being considered for legislation next year. The Canvassing Board reviewed the audit report.

Ms. Armstrong requested that the sealed boxes containing counted ballots be opened in order to consolidate the ballots and limit storage space needed. The Canvassing Board approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 a.m. with notice that the Canvassing Board would reconvene Tuesday, August 20, at 8:30 a.m. at the Elections office to certify the election.


Canvassing Board members reviewed the reports. Ms. Armstrong explained how the numbers on the reports were obtained. She further noted that VoteWA and Verity numbers of ballots accepted balanced. Ms. Armstrong commented that five people had cured signatures since the Canvassing Board last met and that these ballots had been counted.

Mr. Stephens questioned why the VoteWA Reconciliation Report did not match the Verity Official Cumulative Report in regards to votes counted. It was also noted that the VoteWA Reconciliation Report never arrived at the total number of votes counted. Ms. Armstrong and Ms. Henley noted that VoteWA is still being developed, and that other counties have experienced issues reconciling. Ms. Armstrong produced the page she used to calculate the number of votes counted, which the Canvassing Board reviewed.

Canvassing Board members signed the Oath of Authenticity and Certification of Canvassing Board to certify the August 6, 2019 Primary.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 a.m.
