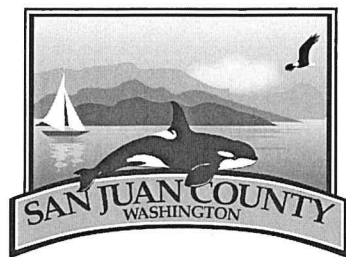

The Canvassing Board reviewed forty-six challenged envelopes and accepted two. One ballot was accepted because a hand cancellation from the post office noted that the ballot was mailed on Election Day, February 11. The other accepted ballot was from the mismatched signature group.

The Canvassing Board reviewed seven challenged ballots and accepted all seven. All challenged ballots were challenged because of voter intent.

The Canvassing Board reviewed ten additional challenges. The first was rejected because the voter had not provided ID. The remaining ballots were re-issues with a ballot already accepted for each of the nine voters.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:20 a.m. with notice that the Canvassing Board would reconvene Friday, February 21, at 8:30 a.m. at the Elections office to certify the election.


