A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PRIMITIVE ROADS IN SAN <sup>Sr</sup>JUAN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County Council desires to classify and designate the County Road segments as set forth in Attachment A as primitive roads;

1. The County Road segments set forth in Attachment A are hereby classified and designated as primitive roads and the County Engineer is directed to appropriately sign these road segments.
